Improved Patient-Centered Treatment Outcomes for Substance Use Disorders.

Proven-effective patient treatment for substance use disorders include, Office-Based Addiction Treatment (OBAT) and Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT). Substance use disorders is increasingly being treated with Buprenorphine (Zubsolv, Bunavail, Subutex, Suboxone) due to its effectiveness to both activate and block substance addiction receptors. Naloxone is added to certain formulations as an abuse deterrent.
